Welcome Back! from the Health Office

September is rapidly approaching, and as unhappy as I am to see summer draw to a close, nothing will make me happier than seeing the smiling faces of all of your children arriving for their first day of school. Their enthusiasm and excitement are absolutely contagious.

Speaking of contagious, a few "Healthful" reminders:

- * All immunization and physical Examination records for new students are due in my office before school starts. New students cannot begin school without this.
- Doctors orders are needed for any medications that are to be dispensed out
 of the Health Office. Please remember, I cannot give <u>ANYTHING</u> to your
 children, including Tylenol or eye drops, without a written order from their
 pediatrician. It is extremely helpful to get me any orders and medications
 before school starts.
- If your child will be absent from school, please call or email the Health office and leave a detailed message with the reason for their absence. State law requires me to call home if we have not been given notice of a child's absence.
- Colonial Road School is a "Nut Aware" building meaning no nuts or products produced in a facility with nuts are allowed in any of the classrooms. All food must be labeled as such.

Please remember I am always available with any questions or problems that you may have. Enjoy the rest of the summer!




CRS PTA RETURNED CHECK POLICY

Sometimes, checks bounce! Mistakes happen...we've all been there! But as PTA volunteers, we sometimes find ourselves in the uncomfortable position of having to follow up on returned checks with our fellow CRS families. This year, we want to make our returned check policy clear to all!

In the event that a check is returned, the payer will be responsible for providing timely payment in the expected amount, along with the \$25 returned check fee. CRS PTA will reserve the right to take appropriate measures when returned checks go unpaid.

With proper resolution, each payer will be allowed two returned checks, after which payment by check will not be accepted (cash and certified fund payments will be allowed).





CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

CHOPPED: Learn how to make quick family style meals using seasonal ingredients such as Tomatoes, Pumpkin, Squash, Apples, Beans, Greens, Rice, and meaningful grains. Students receive recipes, learn how to prep properly, knife skills review, and plating how to's...but how they put their spin on a dish, that's the main objective! Let's get creative!

Cost: \$160

GOLF: Golf instruction, activities, and details on the history of golf are incorporated while teaching junior golfers interpersonal skills through the rules and etiquette of the game.

Cost: \$160

LACROSSE: Improve hand-eye coordination to be able to catch and throw the ball. Participate in active ball drills (throwing, catching, ground balls, etc.) and enhance the 1 and 2 handed cradle into lacrosse dodges (split, face, roll). Basic introduction to speed and agility.

Cost: \$160

LITERACY & ART: This art experience is based on a quality, age-appropriate children's book. In addition to stimulating your child's artistic abilities, focus is placed on language development and higher-level thinking skills. Cost: \$130

ROBOTICS: LEGO[®] WeDo 2.0, Bricks, and Tablets emphasize a mixture of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math). Rewarding hands-on experience keep children engaged in the learning process, and foster curiosity about science and math. Build and program robots to perform a variety of different functions. For example, robots can be fitted with sensors, which control motors and react to light, sound, touch, etc.

Cost: \$160

SEWING: Hand sewing and an introduction to sewing machine parts comprise this class. Session projects include an infinity scarf and a solid knit waterfall hooded cardigan. Includes materials fee.
